ABOUT US

NAVYUG FOUNDATION is a non-profit organization operational since 2015 with a vision “We commit ourselves to supporting the underprivileged in our society and support the government to improve governance.”

NAVYUG FOUNDATION exists to make significant contributions to education in a manner consistent with social justice, equity, humane values, and sustainability within the framework of secular and democratic Indian polity. A number of key principles continue to guide the process of the Society’s evolution. These principles deeply inform our strategy and approach at many levels and are worth articulating here.

Operating Organization: We are an operating organization and not a funding organization. We recognize the importance of creating institutional “social infrastructure” to complement the government, and as an operating or implementing organization, we work in partnership with the government to improve the quality of education across the country.

Education and Allied Areas as the Domain of Work: Education is a powerful vehicle for social change, and it is the primary focus of our work. We work primarily for India’s large underprivileged and marginalized population. Related domains such as health, nutrition, livelihoods, governance, and ecology also have a critical bearing on education. We work in these areas, addressing their complex inter-related structure. However, we realize that it is not possible for a single organization to work with equal intensity and focus in all these areas, and therefore we calibrate our efforts based on the nature of the specific challenges, our own capabilities and our ability to work with partners, and extended resources.



Scale of Work: We seek systemic change – all our work is aimed at creating large – scale impact either directly or indirectly. Such system – wide change that touches the large underprivileged population of India is possible only by working in close partnership with the government. However, we are also open to work independently as well as with other private institutions, if required.

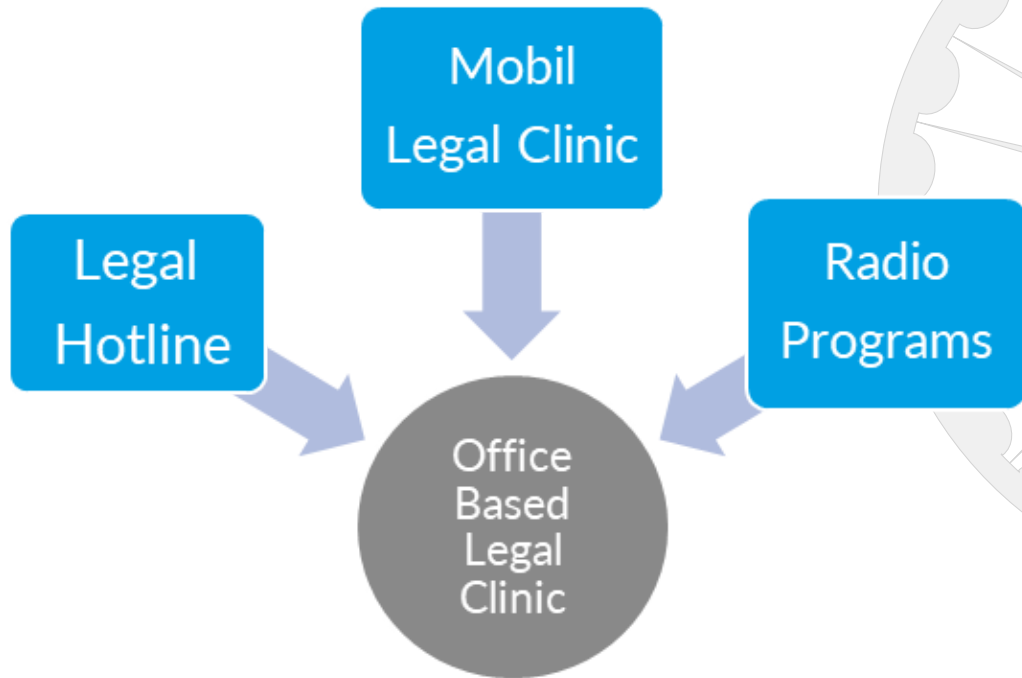

LEGAL LITERACY CAMP

AWARENESS ON RIGHT TO INFORMATION ACT (RTI)

NAVYUG FOUNDATION has been conducting for each every meeting creating awareness on the RTI and its purpose. As the corruption and red-tapisam are rampant in public offices in rise, the Right to Information Act, 2005 has come as a boon for Indian citizens giving them the rights to access information and services they need from public offices. If effectively implemented, RTI can bring in openness and transparency between public authorities and rural people to help enhance informed citizenry and socio-economic development in rural areas; the awareness level in rural areas is still low on the Act. Because ignorance and lack of knowledge of the rural/slum people who were often deprived of their rights and incurred huge transactional costs for making several visits to access info/services from public offices for issues related to their livelihood security and basic needs. With the effective implementation of the RTI Act the people are seeking information from various authorities in order to ascertain and verify the truth.

EDUCATION FOR POOR CHILDREN IN INDIA

NAVYUG FOUNDATION is an NGO that working for the welfare of poor children in India. Children are the future of our nation & need special focus



to make them educate. Education for poor children is a dream mission for NAVYUG FOUNDATION that focuses on basic education for poor children and youth and makes it possible for an individual to sponsor the cost of education or total. Children are entitled to a free, quality basic education. Recognizing this entitlement is necessary to be known by every child of our nation.

NAVYUG FOUNDATION aims to deliver free quality education to underprivileged children across rural India. This rural education initiative focuses on setting up “temples of learning radiating knowledge and excellence for underprivileged children” in the rural pockets of India to provide quality education to poor children to develop them into confident, employable and responsible citizens of tomorrow.

DISABLED CHILDREN

Disabled Children Programme was a challenge because social attitudes and stigma play an important role in limiting the opportunities for disabled people in social and economic life, often even within their own families. Disabled Children Programme is meant for supporting disabled children from the communities so that they can sustain their Endeavor for education and maintain good health and in the process become self reliant and self dependent. It helps to break the cycle of poverty, despair and hopelessness by nurturing the disabled child within a developing community. The child's basic physical needs are assured, including education, medical care and clothing. We are making efforts to give quality education to children with special needs. And we proudly say that one of our disabled sponsored children completed her B.Tech in a prestigious college. We hope that this project is very helpful to the disabled children in future.

FREE DISTRIBUTION OF BOOKS, CLOTHS & GIFT BOXES TO POOR CHILDREN

As a part its ongoing services towards the student community has been distributing free notebooks, uniforms to the poor students from the nearby government schools.



Every year around 250 poor students were given note books & stationery, uniforms. The articles were distributed by the dignitaries present during the meeting. This year, a massive arrangement for free distribution of notebooks was made to the poor primary school students, In the various adjoining areas of Delhi & Bihar state.

NAVYUG FOUNDATION once again stretched its philanthropic services and distribution of note-books and stationery, cloths to under-privileged school children of Government school. The dignitaries distributed those note-books to the gathering poor students of the school.

FREE TUITION CENTERS

In continuation with the past years free tuition centers, it has been conducting free tuition centers for marginalized children. The organization has been working for improvement of educational status of rural and tribal poor. During the last 1 years we are conducting free tuition centers at Delhi & Bihar for rural and SC/OBC Student. It has been reported in the previous year report that has analyzed vulnerability situation of children. In the targeted areas, SC/ST community of people stays in distant colonies from the main village. Most children in our target communities are studying in government schools. These children often find it difficult to cope with their formal studies. This leads to their dropping out. Or they reach X standard level and then fail the exam. These children hail from economically poor background families Children from these communities lag behind their other community counterparts in primary and high schools. By the time they reach grade 5, these children are, on an average, two years behind the formal curriculum. This handicap continues throughout their school, resulting in a high failure and dropout rate. Through the Free Coaching Centers, provides supplementary and special classes to the school going children of the backward communities. The supplementary classes, through its relevant teaching methods helps children attending primary and high schools cope with their school curriculum. It is not a tuition class that helps students attains high grades. In these classes, limitations of students, in terms of cognitive and psychological needs are identified. Through relevant teaching methods and psychological support, children's self-confidence and self-esteem are enhanced leading to an ability to cope in and outside school.
